The Culture Unlimited Festival focuses on new or rarely heard music — especially from the Eastern world — presented alongside contemporary Western repertoires. Local community participation is central to the programme, which spans contemporary classical, jazz, pop, electronic, and Eastern folk traditions.

Activity Report 2022

In 2022, no public festival or cultural activities were organised. Instead, the foundation focused on preparing the programme, partnerships, and funding for the 2023 edition of the Culture Unlimited Festival. The year was dedicated to strengthening organisational capacity and securing resources to ensure the successful relaunch of activities in 2023.

- Expenditure focused on artist fees, production, technical support, communication, and outreach

The foundation is governed by an unpaid, volunteer board. Project staff and freelancers are contracted per project. Artists and professionals are remunerated according to sector standards and fair fee guidelines.
